**Shelley M. Jagow**, Professor of Music at Wright State University (Dayton), serves as music educator and director of the Symphonic Band and Saxophone Quartet. As a Selmer Artist Clinician, she performs with local bands and orchestras, and is invited at the state, national and international levels to present clinics and performances, and serve as honor band conductor and adjudicator. Shelley has published numerous articles in periodicals, and is a contributing author to *The Music Director's Cookbook* (Meredith Music), *Teaching Music Through Performance* series (GIA Music), and is author of the book and DVD of *Teaching Instrumental Music: Developing the Complete Band Program* (Meredith Music).

She earned Music Education degrees from the University of Saskatchewan (Canada) and the University of Missouri (Columbia). She earned her Ph. D. in Music Education at the Union Institute & University (Cincinnati) where Colonel Timothy Foley, Frank Battisti, and Edward Wingard served as her mentors.
