Alderson Broaddus University is seeking faculty for the School of Anatomical Science. The invited application is for 12-month faculty position that will involve teaching Gross Anatomy and its various aspects such as Embryology, Histology, and Neuroanatomy along with cadaver dissection for the Master of Science in Anatomy program. The successful candidate will actively conduct biomedical research in collaboration with the Chair of the School of Anatomical Science with the goal of obtaining extramural funding for the research program. The faculty will also participate in curriculum development, and other scholarly activities. The faculty is expected to remain current in the professional field of interest and participate in all assigned, required as well as other related professional services and activities in the College of Medical Science at Alderson Broaddus University.

Essential duties and responsibilities include:

1. Maintain current knowledge of Human Anatomy, Embryology, Histology and Neuroanatomy
2. Provide classroom and laboratory instruction in gross anatomy, embryology, histology and neuroanatomy
3. Provide instruction in anatomy cadaver laboratory
4. Participate in biomedical research and work in collaboration with department Chair in developing and seeking future funding for the research program.
5. Participate in faculty development and meetings and facilitate positive work environment especially in interaction with graduate students, other faculty and staff members
6. Attend educational and research conferences along with encouraging / mentoring and involving graduate students in research and represent Alderson Broaddus University in a positive manner
7. Submit an annual faculty activities report
8. Perform all the duties assigned and as listed in the employment contract

Requirements for the position are:

A PhD in anatomical related field such as Human Anatomy, Embryology, Developmental Biology, Neuroanatomy or any basic science or equivalent degree from an accredited institution. Prior graduate teaching experience involving cadaveric dissection and post-doctoral research fellowship with grant writing skill is preferred.
