

## **Tenure-track Faculty Position in Music: Piano/Theory/Musicianship**

Qualifications for position: Applicants for the position should possess a minimum of a master's degree in Music with emphasis in Piano and music theory/aural skills; a doctorate is preferred. The applicant should demonstrate evidence of successful teaching (preference at the college-level, other considered), should possess good communication skills, and demonstrate the ability to work collegially with other higher education faculty within the School of Music and across the institution.
