*The University's temporary mask requirement is being extended through at least Friday, September 24, 2021. **All members of the campus community (vaccinated and non-vaccinated) are required to wear masks or face coverings while indoors.*** Masks are not required outdoors, when alone in offices, or when in one's own residence room or suite. Social distancing while unmasked outdoors is encouraged.

This extension of the requirement is in response to guidance from the Barbour County Health Department as well as the current COVID-19 cases on our campus. Currently, the University is tracking 14 students and 4 faculty and staff who have recently tested positive for COVID-19. If you have not been vaccinated, please consider protecting yourself and others by getting your shot. The vaccine is readily available in our community and the University is willing to offer them on campus. We will send a survey out soon to determine on-campus interest.
