The University's temporary mask requirement is being extended through at least Friday, October 8, 2021. All members of the campus community (vaccinated and non-vaccinated) are required to wear masks or face coverings while indoors. Masks are not required outdoors, when alone in offices, or when in one's own residence room or suite. Social distancing while unmasked outdoors is encouraged.

This extension of the requirement is in response to guidance from the Barbour County Health Department as well as the current COVID-19 cases on our campus. Currently, the University is tracking 5 students and 1 faculty and staff member who have recently tested positive for COVID-19. The decreasing number of students testing positive is a good sign. Continued vigilance in safety protocols is critical in preventing another spike in cases.

If you have not been vaccinated, please consider protecting yourself and others by getting your shot. The University is offering 30 vaccines to students and employees on Tuesday, September 28. A separate email has been sent inviting anyone who has not been vaccinated to an opportunity to make an appointment.
