We continue to track developments related to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Omicron variant has been determined to be more contagious than previous versions of the virus. The recent surge in cases means each of us must take several precautions before returning to the spring semester.

Please review carefully:

- If you are experiencing **ANY symptoms**, even mild symptoms such as nasal congestion, cough, or headache, please do not return to campus without first being tested.
- If you have had a known exposure to a positive COVID case, please get a test before returning to campus.
- The State of WV Higher Education Policy Commission is asking that we test ALL students as they return to campus. Students will receive instructions in a separate email outlining the procedures for getting the test.
- Remember that all unvaccinated persons must wear a mask when indoors. Given the nature of the current surge in cases, the University highly recommends that both vaccinated and unvaccinated persons wear masks when indoor.

If you have not been vaccinated, please consider protecting yourself and others by getting your shot. The vaccine is also readily available in our community.
