Student-Athlete Serious Misconduct Attestation Form

Alderson Broaddus University and the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) are committed to sexual violence prevention. Requirements

1. Who:

All prospective (**first year**), incoming (**transfer**) and **returning** student-athletes.

2. When:

Every year of intercollegiate athletics participation (includes tryout, practice and competition).

3. What:

Attest (disclose) if the prospective/incoming/returning student-athlete has been disciplined through a Title IX or sexual misconduct proceeding or criminally convicted, regardless of the degree, and whether the result of a plea or court determination, of either of the following:

- **Sexual Violence:** A term used to include both forcible and nonforcible sex offenses, ranging from sexual battery, sexual assault to rape.
- **Interpersonal Violence:** Violence that is predominantly caused due to the relationship between the victim and the perpetrator, including dating and domestic violence.
- **Other Acts of Violence:** Crimes including murder, manslaughter, aggravated assault or any assault that employs the use of a deadly weapon or causes serious bodily injury.
- **Other Forms of Serious Misconduct:** Crimes, including felony drug possession/distribution, felony theft, arson, or multiple DUI/DWIs.
